**Awards Ceremony:** Thursday, August 2, 2012 | **8:00-8:30 p.m.** | Kensington Court, 610 Hilton Blvd., (near Briarwood Mall)

Prizes will be awarded in six (6) categories (*the grade they are going into in the fall; with the exception of recently graduated 12th graders - they may still enter as 12th grade*):

**Preschool, Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, Grades 9-12 & Adults.**

**Prizes:**

Within each category there will be three winners: **1<sup>st</sup> Place, 1 Runner-up and 1 Honorable Mention.**

Winners will receive gift certificates for *Target* in the amounts of **\$35.00, \$25.00 and \$15.00** respectively.

Winners will also receive prize ribbons.

**Prize ribbons will also be awarded in each category for the following:**

*Best Motorized project; Best Architectural/Engineering project; Coolest Robot; Best Vehicle; Most Creative; Most Sophisticated and, AADL Lego® Master Builder!*

**People's Choice Award!** All attendees of the LEGO contest may vote for one entry in each age category from 6:00-8:00 p.m. People's Choice Winners will receive a special LEGO trophy.

**Rules:**

1. Use your own Lego®, Duplo, Megablocks or other Lego® compatible plastic brick.
2. Entries must be your own creation, not a Lego® designed kit, project found online, in a magazine etc.
3. One entry per participant or team where applicable.
4. Your creation must fit within a space of 24 by 24 inches. Your completed project may be no taller than four feet tall.
5. Team projects will be placed in the category of the **oldest** participant in the team. Individual entries will not be permitted for team participants. Please note that while all members of a team will receive a prize ribbon (if applicable) a team will compete for a single prize.
6. Please provide a sign/label with your project with your name(s), grade and phone #. The sign must also explain the idea/inspiration for your creation to help the judges make their determinations.
7. Completed projects must be delivered to **Kensington Court, 610 Hilton Blvd on Thursday, August 2 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**
8. Judging will be conducted the evening of Thursday, August 2 at Kensington Court by a team of adult LEGO® enthusiasts. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m. to allow for the entries to be viewed by the public.
9. The Awards Ceremony will begin at 8:00 p.m on Thursday, August 2.
10. Completed entries **MUST** be taken home on the evening of Thursday, August, 2 after the ceremony ends at **8:30 p.m.**
